Celtic Music from the Celtic World



Moch Pryderi is one of Virginia's oldest Pan-celtic bands. Together for 18 years, the band performs the traditional celtic reels, jigs, and ballads from Wales, Ireland, Scotland, Brittany and Galicia with occasional forays into traditional Appalachian American music. The band has extensive experience playing in Celtic festivals, Irish Pubs, St. Patrick's day events, Burns nights, and Welsh festivals throughout the eastern US. The band's instrumentation consists of Celtic Harps, including the rare Welsh Triple Harp, Irish Bouzoukis, Fiddle, Bodhran, Great Highland pipes, small pipes, pibgorns, mandolin, flute and whistles.

Moch Pryderi has performed widely on the east coast, including the Millennium Stage at the Kennedy Center in Washington D.C., The Celtic Classic in Bethlehem Pa., the Philadelphia Folk Festival, the Washington Folk Festival, the Fredericksburg Welsh Festival, the Philadelphia Welsh

Festival, the Historic Rugby Tennessee Festival of British & Appalachian Culture, the Celtic Nations Heritage Festival in Lake Charles Louisiana, the Welsh Heritage Center in Wymore Nebraska, and the North American Festival of Wales in Cleveland Ohio.

Moch Pryderi's five CD's "Dancing in the Pigsty", "Belly Jerk", "Jig Moch", "Moch IV" and "Migldi Magldi Moch" contain a rich selection of Welsh, Irish, Breton, Scottish and Galician traditional materials as well as original works. Their 4th CD, "Moch IV", was nominated for the prestigious "WAMMIE" award in the traditional folk music category by the Washington Area Music Association. Their 5th CD, "Migldi Magldi Moch" was just released in September 2016.

Moch Pryderi's members are; Mary Triola, Rik Rice, Bill Reese, Luke Gray and Paul Burgess.

The Band also appears as The Hardtack & Sowbelly String Band, playing the hits of the 1840's 1850's 1860's and 1870's.
